



The University is located in a sylvan surrounding on the western banks of the river Hooghly. The University situated adjacent to the campus of the Indian Botanic Gardens, covers an area of nearly 49 hectares. It is located within 8 km from the heart of the city Kolkata through Vidyasagar Setu and it takes about 20 minutes drive from Raj Bhavan, Kolkata. The nearest suburban railway station is Howrah, which is 6 k.m. from the University campus and the Kolkata Airport is 30 k.m. from the main gate.

In this millennium, with the advent of the globally interdependent business environment, B. E. College has responded to the needs of the industry. At present it offers 2 year fulltime MBA programe and the Ph.D. Program.
