IMPORTANT

1. Mode of application is on-line (www.becs.ac.in) only. Create a login and password for on-line application.
2. When you submit the completed on-line form a money receipt will be generated along with an exact copy of the filled-in application form. Keep the copy of the submitted application form and remit Rs. 512/- (Rs. 500 [fee] + Rs. 12 [bank charge]) in any branch of UBI in India using the bank receipt.
3. Keep the receipts (your copy and University's copy with you). With the payment the application process is completed. **It is mandatory to bring the copy of the filled-in application and the bank payment receipt for test/Interview.**
4. For all full time programmes GATE qualified candidates (those who have got qualifying marks to be eligible for scholarship) will be preferred. However, Non-GATE candidates may also apply. **In case of sufficient number of GATE applicants non-GATE candidates may not even get a call for test and interview. A limited number of scholarships from TEQIP may be available for non-GATE candidates.** For non_GATE candidates for all full-time courses the minimum requirement is to get 65% in all qualifying examinations (Secondary onwards). [B. Sc. and M Sc with 55% will be eligible for some M. tech programme].

Till 1992, it was a constituent college of the Calcutta University and has been offering PG Courses in Engineering since 1954. In recognition of its service to the nation for all these years, the college was elevated to the status of a Deemed University in 1992 and the then Honorable President of India, Dr. Sankar Dayal Sharma formally inaugurated the University on March 13, 1993. From 1st October 2004, the Institute was further elevated to the status of a State University and was renamed as Bengal Engineering and Science University, Shibpur.

The vision of the University is to be one of the best ten excellent engineering and science universities of the country, committed to transforming India to a developed nation and partnering in the realization of the Developed India Vision 2020, through development of world-class engineers and scientists. POST GRADUATE COURSES:

The University offers 4-semester post graduate courses leading to **Master of Engineering (ME)** degree in nine disciplines, namely, Aerospace & Applied Mechanics, Civil, Computer Science & Technology, Electrical, Mechanical, Electronics & Tele-Communication, Information Technology, Metallurgy & Material and Mining Engineering. The department of Architecture, Town and Regional Planning offers **Master of Town & Regional Planning (MTRP)** degree. It also offers **Master of Technology (M. Tech)** degree from some of its schools in Materials Engineering, VLSI Design and Mechatronics. The University also offers 6-semester part time courses.

In addition to above, the University also offers the following post-graduate part time and full time courses:

- 6-semester part time evening post-graduate course in Civil Engineering in five areas of specialization namely Structural Engineering, Geo-technical Engineering and Environmental Engineering, Transportation Engineering and Water Resource Engineering.
- 6-semester part time evening course in Industrial Metallurgy.
- 6-semester part-time M.Tech. courses in Information Technology under the aegis of Purabi Das School of Information Technology (PDSIT).
- 6-Semester Part Time M.Tech courses in Safety and Occupational Health Engineering
- 4-semester full time course in Master of Business Administrator (MBA) under the aegis of School of Management Science (SOMS).
- 4-semester M.Sc. courses in Applied Chemistry, Applied Geology, Applied Mathematics, Applied Physics and Geo-informatics.

The University has been approved as a Q.I.P. Centre for **Master of Engineering** Courses in Civil Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Mining Engineering and Computer Science and Technology disciplines and for **Ph.D.** in Civil Engineering.

In addition to regular Ph.D. programme, the University also offers research facilities in a wide range of fields of Engineering, Science and Technology through a large number of R&D projects sponsored by National and International Agencies.

ELIGIBILITY

- A.i) The candidates for admission to the fulltime **postgraduate courses** in Engineering/Technology/Architecture must possess a Degree in Engineering/Architecture of this University *or* any other University/Institution as recognized by Bengal Engineering and Science University, Shibpur *or* equivalent to Bachelor's Degree in Engineering/Technology/ Architecture for that purpose. The candidates whose results in the qualifying examination are yet to be declared but have succeeded in GATE examination are also eligible to apply subject to the conditions stated in clause (C) below.
- ii) A pass in A.M.I.E. Examinations in particular branch of Engineering/A.M.I.I.M./ A.M.I.E.T.E. Examination with B.Sc. of any recognized University with Physical

Science *or* with Licentiate Engineering Diploma of a recognized institute will be considered as an equivalent qualification for that branch of Engineering/Technology.

- iii) For admission to **MTRP programme** the following will be considered as an equivalent qualification: A good Bachelor Degree (in Architecture/Civil/Planning) from a recognized University or a Deemed University OR AIIA or AMIE with or without GATE qualification OR a regular Post Graduate Degree in M.A./M.Sc. (in Economics/Geography/Sociology) with or without NET qualification
- iv) For admission to **Master of Technology course in (a) Materials Design and Application**, the candidate must possess a degree BE/ B.Tech in Metallurgical, Materials, Mechanical, Production, Civil, Chemical, Ceramic, Polymer, Electrical and Electronics Engineering, Jute/Fiber Technology and any subject in the purview of Applied Physics, Applied Chemistry *or* equivalent.
M.Sc in Physics, Chemistry and Geology and any subject in the purview of Applied Physics and Applied Chemistry.
Mathematics.
- v) For admission to **Master of Technology course in VLSI Design**, the candidate must possess a degree (BE/BTech.) in Computer Science and Technology/Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering/Electrical Engineering/Information Technology from any University/Institution as recognized by Bengal Engineering and Science University, Shibpur
- vi) For admission to **M.Tech Programme in Mechatronics :**

The M.Tech in Mechatronics is a programme being conducted jointly by Bengal Engineering and Science University, Shibpur and Council of Scientific and Industrial Research, New Delhi, through its associated Institutes; Central Electronics Engineering Research Institute, Pilani, Central Scientific Instrument organization, Chandigarh and Central Mechanical Engineering Research Institute, Durgapur.

The program will be of two years duration and will be conducted by the participating Institutes by utilizing their expertise and facilities available. While the course will be conducted at BESU, CEERI, Pilani, CSIO, Chandigarh and CMERI, Durgapur, the academic degree will be awarded to students by BESU on successful completion of the course.

- (a) Eligibility: for **18 seats** qualification required is a valid GATE score with a minimum of 60% marks in B.E./B.Tech. in Mechanical/Production/Manufacturing Engg/ Aeronautical/Electrical/Electronics/Telecommunication/Instrumentation /Control/Automobile Engineering. Non-GATE candidates may also apply.
- (b) Admission procedure: as per rules of Bengal Engineering and Science University, Shibpur.
- (c) Reservation norms will be applicable as per the University Rules.
- (d) All the academic rules of BESUS (where applicable) will be followed for the programme.

- (e) Course structure: subjects will be covered by the BESU and the participating Institutes of CSIR at CEERI, CSIO and CMERI.
- B. As per the directives of the **Ministry of Human Resources Development (MHRD), Govt. of India**, the following procedure is to be adopted for admission to postgraduate programmes with Scholarship/Assistantship. The **GATE** score obtained by the candidate will be considered for admission. If the candidate is to be selected through written test/interview for postgraduate programmes, not less than 70% weight is to be given for the GATE score and the remaining up to 30% to the marks obtained by the candidate in his/her qualifying examination or interview.
- C. All candidates who are eligible for admission but whose results are yet to be declared, will be allowed provisional admission, if selected, on production of **Course Completion Certificate** from appropriate authorities. They will be required to submit their results of the qualifying degree examinations by 30.09.2013 failing which their admission may be treated as cancelled.

Notes

- i) **Candidates who qualified in the GATE in 2011 or earlier will be treated as Non- GATE Candidates.**
- ii) **Admission for Non-GATE candidates will only be considered according to the merit, if seats remain vacant in respective department after admission of GATE candidates.**
- iii) Those candidates **who do not report for Interview** at the scheduled time, date and venue, as mentioned in back side of the front cover page, will not be eligible for admission in this session. Request for change of time, date and venue for interview will **not** be entertained.
- iv) Certificate for SC/ST: Scheduled caste/Scheduled Tribe candidates in W.B, as specified in Govt of W.B Order No. 112(2)-TW/EC dated 07.03.91 are eligible for seeking admission under SC/ST Quota. SC/ST candidates hailing from states other than West Bengal are not eligible for such benefits and they will be treated as General category candidates.

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENT

To appear in the final/annual examination each student is required to have **at least 75% attendance in each subject.**

DISCIPLINE

Students are expected to observe norms of good behavior, rules and regulations prescribed and orders issued by the university authorities from time to time.

IMPORTANT POINT TO BE NOTED:

If in any particular **field of specialization number of students remains less than five**, the university reserves the right not to run that particular programme. In the event of a particular programme not run by the university, the fee received towards shall be returned to the candidates after closer of the admission process.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications are to be submitted on-line (www.becs.ac.in) only and the application fee (Rs. 500/- per application) is to be paid in any branch of UBI in India (bank Charge is Rs. 15/-) in cash.

Candidates seeking admission to Master of Engineering / Technology degree course in **more than one department** must submit **separate application and remit the corresponding application fee through bank.**

ADMISSION PROCEDURE AND OTHER DETAILS FOR FULL TIME COURSES

- I. A department/school-wise list of eligible candidates called for interview/test, as decided by the respective department/school, will be displayed in the website. Interview will be held in the respective department/school as per the schedule declared in the website.
- II. Listed candidates (GATE) are required to appear for interview and the **non-GATE candidates** will have to appear for a test followed by the interview as the schedule.
- III. Certificates and testimonials will be checked on the date of Interview/Test. Candidates must bring the copy of the filled in application form (containing their photograph) along with them as the identity document.**
- IV. A department/school-wise merit list of candidates will be made for both General and SC/ST/PH categories on the basis of 70% weight for the GATE score and 30% weight for performance in interview. Merit list for non-GATE candidates will be made on the basis of 70% weight on the results of selection test, and 30% weight on the performance in interview. Department/school-wise merit lists for candidates eligible for counselling will be displayed in the website. If the result of final examination is not published at the time of interview, selection shall be made on the results of previous semester /part of qualifying examinations.
- V. Candidates fail to report for interview will **not** be eligible for admission.
- VI. The counselling of the merit-listed candidates will be held on scheduled date and time as notified in the website.
- VII. On receipt of **offer document** for admission from the respective Head of the Department on the date of counselling, the candidate will have to report for admission to the respective courses to the admission cell under the Office of the Registrar, Bengal Engineering and Science University, Shibpur as per the scheduled date between 10-30 a.m. to 1-30 p.m. and 2-30 p.m. to 5-00 p.m. with the following documents:
 - (a) Offer letter issued by respective department
 - (b) Original mark sheets of all semester / part examinations and certificates
 - (c) Three copies of stamp size photograph
 - (d) Medical certificate along with the Blood Group
 - (e) The GATE score card (original), where applicable
 - (f) Demand Draft/ Pay Order for the amount as stated in item VIII below.
 - (g) Migration certificate issued by the university from which the candidate has come (see item X) .

VIII. A 2nd list of Candidate(s), if necessary, will be displayed in the website. Counseling and admission of candidates under the 2nd Merit list will be held as per schedule. On receipt of offer for admission, the candidates will have to report to the Admission Cell, under the office of the Registrar with documents as mentioned in item VII above.

- X. On receiving the offer for admission, if a candidate fails to take admission in the respective course on scheduled date and time, the offer for admission to PG-course made to him **will stand cancelled** and the vacancy arising thereof **will be filled up by** candidates in waiting list.
- XI. **The admission of students migrating from other Universities is provisional and subject to approval of the Universities, from which they come.**
- XII. The session will commence on and from 8th July, 2013. The students admitted must report to the respective Head of the department along with the Provisional **Admission Certificate** issued by the Registrar. Regarding class routine the candidates should contact concerned Head/Director of the Department/School.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE : Only GATE candidates with marks more than or equal to the qualification marks stated in the GATE certificate are eligible for P. G. Scholarship for AICTE approved full-time courses only as per AICTE norms. A limited number of scholarships are likely to be available under the non-GATE category from TEQIP.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE AND OTHER DETAILS FOR PART TIME [EVENING] COURSES

- I. A department/school-wise list of eligible candidates called for interview, as decided by the respective department/school, will be available in the website. **(Note: for PDSIT both test and interview are taken for admission)**
- II. Those candidates, who fail to report for interview, will **not** be eligible for admission.
- III. On receipt of **offer document** for 1st admission from the respective Head of the Department/School on the day of counseling the candidate will have to report for admission to the respective courses to the Admission cell under the Office of the Registrar, Bengal Engineering and Science University, Shibpur as per schedule between 10-30 a.m. and 1-30 p.m./ 2-30 p.m. and 5-00 p.m. with the following documents:
- (a) Offer letter issued by respective department/school
 - (b) Original mark sheets of all semester/part examinations and certificates
 - (c) Three copies of stamp size photograph
 - (d) Medical certificate along with the Blood Group
 - (e) The GATE score card (original), where applicable
 - (f) Demand Draft/ Pay Order for the amount as stated in item VI below.
 - (g) Migration certificate issued by the university from which the candidate has come.

IV. Name of the candidates from the same merit list eligible for 2nd admission will be displayed in the website. The process for counseling and admission will be similar as before.

V. Tuition Fee payable per Semester:

Per semester tuition fee for all the part time courses are Rs. 15,000/- except the part time course offered by PDSIT for which the tuition fee per semester is Rs. 40,000/-. Also note that tuition fee for ME programmes in Civil Engineering and Metallurgy & Materials Engineering Department are likely to be revised.

VI. Fees to be paid at the time of admission:

Examination fees are to be paid by the students at the end of each semester as per the notification of the Controller of Examinations, BESU, Shibpur.

VII. On receiving the offer for admission, if a candidate fails to take admission in the respective course on scheduled date and time, the offer for admission to PG-course made to him **will stand cancelled. In order to fill in the vacant seats the University will declare the name of the candidates from the same merit list who are eligible for further admission.**

VIII. **The admission of students migrating from other Universities is provisional and subject to approval of the Universities from which they come.**

IX. The session will commence on and from **8th July, 2013**. The students admitted must report to the respective Head of the department/school along with the Provisional **Admission Certificate** issued by the Registrar. Regarding class routine the candidates should contact concerned Head of the Department/school.

MORE DETAILS ON THE APPLICATION PROCESS

- i) The admission process is specifically designed to reduce the time and money normally required for similar application process.
- ii) Check your eligibility for a particular programme from the brochure and then apply.
- iii) You can apply for any department/school (any specialization) if you are eligible. However, for each such case you need to pay the application fee separately for each application. You have to create separate login and password for each such application. Though we will try our best to arrange for non-overlapped date and time for the test and interview for separate department/schools apply judiciously as the date and time for the viva-voce/test may collide if you have made multiple applications.
- iv) You need not send any certificate/testimonial along with your application. Certificates and Testimonials will be checked on the date of Test/Interview.
- v) Be careful to provide correct figures and facts in the application. Any anomaly with the data provided in the application and corresponding data in the certificate/testimonials leads to cancellation of the application and even expulsion from the Institute in case anomaly is revealed after the admission process.
- vi) The remittance of the application fee in the bank within the due date completes the admission process.
- vii) Payment status may also be checked using your login/password on or after 8th June 2013. **If your status is showing non-payment in spite of your payment you should immediately send e-mail to deanfet@becs.ac.in along with the scanned copy of the payment receipt attached to the mail.
